REPORT OF THE DENOMINATIONAL SEARCH COMMITTEE

The committee consists of the following persons: Miriam Funderburk, Jarrett Harrison, Cassie Hudson, Bradley Jones, Dick Porter, Matt Sanders, Fran Sheffield, Seth Stanaland, Frances Thrower, and Ed Wood. All members have participated in one or more of our meetings and all have unanimously approved our recommendation as set out herein.

Various options were considered of where CFUM goes or how it operates following the approval of its disaffiliation by the South Georgia Conference of the United Methodist Church. Among those considered were Global Methodist Church, Congregational Methodist Church, Free Methodist Church, Wesleyan Church, Association of Independent Methodists, and Church of the Nazarene. Operating without a denomination as a private church was also discussed.

First of all, we recommend that we join a denomination similar to the South Georgia Conference of the United Methodist Church (SGUMC), but with certain changes dealing with the following matters:

- 1. Beliefs as to marriage and sexual behavior
- 2. Trust Clause
- 3. Apportionments
- 4. Appointments and terms of Clergy
- 5. Accountability as to (a) use funds and (b) enforcement of violations of our beliefs and Discipline by Clergy and Bishops
- 6. Unrestricted disaffiliation

The committee has studied and spent considerable time discussing and reviewing THE "TRANSITIONAL BOOK OF DOCTRINES AND DISCIPLINE" of GLOBAL METHODIST CHURCH (the Discipline). The 6 items listed above are included and covered in the Discipline. The manner those are included in the Discipline are satisfactory and approved by the committee.

Accordingly, and second, the Committee recommends to the LAITY COUN-CIL that we join and affiliate with the Global Methodist Church.

The third recommendation of the committee deals with the timing following disaffiliation from the South Georgia Conference. This committee further discussed the need to conclude expeditiously the disaffiliation from the
