Our affiliation with the Global Methodists officially starts on January 1, 2024. Between now and then there is not too much left to do. There is some paperwork to be filed, a couple of phone calls to make and then the Global Methodist Church will welcome us into the South Georgia Conference of our new denomination.



At our October 23rd meeting, your Laity Council will vote on our new name that we will start using January 1, 2024.
