If that cause is eternal, an eternal significance is given to his dying. But if not, his attachment to it give him the distinction of a patriot and a hero, but not necessarily that of a saint.

To die for justice, for freedom, links a man to something different from more devotion to a flag. Justice is not temporal, it is eternal. In dying for it, one gives significance to his final act.
