HURRICANE RESCUE

Hard times, emergencies and Natural Disasters often bring out the best in many Americans. Here is one such story coming out of North Carolina.

Tim is 50 years old and has aging parents who live in a nice well built home in a remote area in the mountains just outside Ashville, NC. Like most people in the area, Tim's parents lost their power and cell service as Hurricane Helene spilled over into eastern Tennessee and western North Carolina. Once Tim became aware of the devastation near his parents' home, he drove to the area to go rescue/assist/check on his parents not knowing what condition he might find them in. Because of all the rain and flooding, every road Tim could have used to get to his parents was washed out, flooded or blocked by down trees. Undeterred, Tim loaded up the supplies he knew his parents would need and hiked 11 miles up the mountain climbing over downed trees, wading through floodwaters and navigating his way through woods to get to his parents. He eventually made it and found his parents alive and well with their home intact. This story has a happy inspirational ending. Unfortunately the death toll as of Wednesday approaches 200 with hundreds more missing. Helene will go down as the 2nd deadliest hurricane to strike the mainland US in the last 55 years topped only by Hurricane Katrina in 2005.
