Church Wide Book Study (January 26th - March 26th)

The Book:

The Screwtape Letters written by the legendary C. S. Lewis. A fictitious but biblical look at spiritual battle from the Devil's perspective. The book is a collection of letters written by a Senior devil to a Junior devil as part of the devil's training in how best to tempt, confuse, distract and/or discourage humans in their Christian spiritual journey.

How do I get a Book?

We have ordered 40 and they should be here by this Sunday, January 19th. So you can purchase one (\$5) on Sunday mornings or at Wednesday night supper. You can also call Ruth in the church office to reserve your copy.

How can I participate?

- 1. Wednesday night Bible Study at 6:45 pm. Beginning on January 29th, we will feature The Screwtape Letters for 9 consecutive Wednesdays in our Bible Study. There will be discussion questions available each Sunday prior to that week's study so you can prepare ahead of time.
- 2. Sunday Worship January 26th, Rev. Vernon will preach on "Spiritual Battle" to introduce the Church-wide book study. There also will be 1-2 more Sunday sermons on The Screwtape Letters before we finish the study.
- 3. Read along on your own

Although I hope you will come on Wednesday nights, you may just want to purchase a book and read on your own pace with or without the discussion questions.
