The process has just gotten underway and our Search Committee has begun receiving Pastor resumes from the Global Methodist Church. Keep in mind, the deadline for an individual church or a Pastor to declare a desire for a new Pastor or a new Church is the end of February so again we are early in the process. I would also ask you to remember that about 90% of what the Pastoral Search Committee discusses is confidential so if you ask them questions about what they are discussing, they probably will not be able to comment on it. With that said, let me address one of the most common questions we are already getting about the process.

How will the final decision on choosing our new Pastor be made?

So after reviewing Pastor resumes, our Search Committee then moves to in-person interviews and meetings. Once our Search Committee has locked in on their #1 candidate, they then make that recommendation to the full Staff Parish Committee. If Staff Parish votes to hire that person as our Pastor, two more things have to happen before it becomes official:

- 1. Pastoral Candidate has to agree to serve here.
- 2. Global Methodist Bishop of South Georgia Conference has to sign off on it.

We wanted you to know this is how our new denomination has asked us to handle it and that they came up with the process not us. I hope this is helpful. Please feel free to ask me any questions you have about the process and I will do my best to answer them.
