The Radical Middle

It has been said that the Narrow Way of Christianity has two steep declines on each side that can lead the believer astray. Too far to the right or the left will take you off course.

At first the path seems right, but soon, either way, you are heading downhill fast. On the left side people can get so focused on caring for people that they forget that God is Holy. They can begin to excuse and ignore sin in the name of love.

On the right side folks can become so focused on sin and law they forget about God's mercy and forgiveness. They only see judgement and forget that Jesus died on the cross so that mercy can triumph over judgement.

This is the trap the Pharisees had fallen into in our scripture today. They were so focused on obeying the Law, they had forgotten that the purpose of the Law was so people could have a relationship with God. They had made obedience to the Law a religion unto itself, which is never what God intended. They took something that was supposed to help people get closer to God and used it to make it impossible for anyone but a privileged few to make it.

And Jesus was setting the record straight. If we aren't careful, we can do the same as the Pharisees or the left- leaning Sadducees. Let's stay in the Radical Middle of that Straight Narrow Way. Love and obey God with all of our hearts, while at the same time loving people right where they are. Offer Jesus's love, give them our hearts, let people know we care. At the same time never compromise the Word of God. That's the Radical Middle. Sounds like Jesus.
