One of the benefits I get as Pastor of CFMC is that often as I'm in my office studying, I get to hear Ed practicing on the pipe organ for Sunday. One day as I was listening, I recognized a tune I had not heard for quite some time that brought back a flood of memories. As it often happened, hymn writers sometimes borrowed familiar tunes of the times and different hymns sometimes have the same or similar tunes and this was the case in this instance. I had known the song as "I Will Arise and Go To Jesus". It had been a favorite of a mentoring mine and became one of mine as well.



The words of the chorus are beautiful and meaningful:

I will arise and go to Jesus He will embrace me with His arms In the arms of my dear Savior O, there are 10,000 charms

The language is old, colloquial even, but deeply moving. The tune is slow and haunting, and is called the Southern Harmony in the Hymnbook. It is a soulful, heart stirring melody. I used to sing the hymn to my children as a lullaby when they were babies.

Ever since that afternoon a couple of weeks ago I have been singing that hymn and it has been so good for my soul. No matter what happens in life, no matter the pain we encounter, no matter what people do, no matter what happens, Jesus is there. Instead of wallowing in sorrow or self pity, let us instead arise and go to Jesus. Let Him embrace us in His arms and allow Him to envelope us in His amazing love and presence. In the arms of our dear Savior there certainly are all the charms we need to heal us, mend our brokenness and restore our souls.

We are going to sing this hymn today (340), it goes well with the text, and I hope you find it a song that stays in your heart too. Maybe it will become one of your favorites
