This Sunday is Christ the King Sunday. It is the last Sunday of the liturgical year, the Sunday before Thanksgiving and the Sunday before Advent begins. That's a lot! Its purpose is to remind us that everything begins and ends with the fact that Jesus is King. He is the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end.

We ended the cycle last week with Jesus talking about the End Times and telling His disciples that all these things must happen, but that they shouldn't be afraid. Sometimes when we look around us and see all the things happening in our world, it is easy to become fearful. Yet we need to remember Jesus' words. We don't need to get fearful or fretful either. Today, we rejoice that Jesus is King and that because of that, all things are possible! This week, we give Him thanks for all He has done and brought us through. Next Sunday, we begin Advent and the journey of the Christmas season. What a Wondrous time the Lord has given us! Thanks be to God!
